He has expertise in pediatric digestive endoscopy. Since 2015, he has developed the fecal microbiota transplantation in children and is treasurer of the GFTF (Groupe Français de Transplantation Fécale). He is also a member of the UMR1149 "Intestinal inflammation" team at INSERM and at the University of Paris and the FHU PaCeMM where he focuses his research on the intestinal microbiota: its evolution, its functions and its role in the development of chronic diseases early in life. He is also developing new approaches for modulating the intestinal microbiota.
