

Umberto Simeoni, MD.

Umberto Simeoni is Professor of Paediatrics at Aix-Marseille Université and Director of the Department of Neonatology at AP-HM University Hospitalin Marseille, France. He is heading the Chair on infancy, Environment and Health at the University Foundation.

He graduated at Louis Pasteur University, Strasbourg, France, where he later worked in the position of Professor of Paediatrics and Director of Neonatal and Pediatric Intensive Care Units at Strasbourg University Hospital, up to 2001.

His research in neonatology and developmental biology is oriented towards the developmental origins of adult diseases, perinatal nephrology, perinatal bioethics, as a member of the UMR-S 1076 INSERM research unit. He authored and co-authored more than 130 referenced articles, several books on neonatology, and more than 250 invited lectures. Past-President of the French Society for Neonatal Research and of the French Society for Perinatal Medicine, he is currently Vice-President of the French-DOHaD Society and President-elect of the European Association of Perinatal Medicine.
